



2023-24 Work-Study Program Application for Students

Purpose

Work Study is a financial assistance program administered by Financial Aid and Awards in the Office of the Registrar. It subsidizes student wages for part-time jobs on campus. This “earn while you learn” program assists you with your education and living costs, while providing you with quality work experiences within one of the many College departments or academic areas.

Eligibility Requirements

To be eligible for the Work Study Program at Georgian, you must:

- Apply to and be selected for a Work Study part-time job on campus
- Be registered as a full-time student (includes co-op) at Georgian College*
- Be eligible to work in Canada (for international students)
- Complete the Work Study application in full, demonstrating financial need through the budget below or through an OSAP assessment (or other Canadian provincial government student loan).
- Are not currently working in another Work Study position (students can only be funded for one Work Study position per term)

*Lakehead-Georgian and ILAC students are not eligible for this program.
