ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

- It is required that students have Level C CPR and Standard First Aid on admission to the program (on-line courses are not acceptable). It is the student's responsibility to renew their Level C CPR certification annually while in the Program. Students are asked to submit a copy of their current Level C CPR and Standard First Aid certificate to the coordinator of the program at registration.
- A tuition deposit payment of \$250 is required in order to secure your seat and register for classes
- If your MTCU funding has not come through by the due date, you are responsible for making the minimum payment of \$250
- Second Career students who are approved under the Second Career program and who pay their deposit will not be charged the late fee provided the full fees are covered
