This program will provide the **students** with:

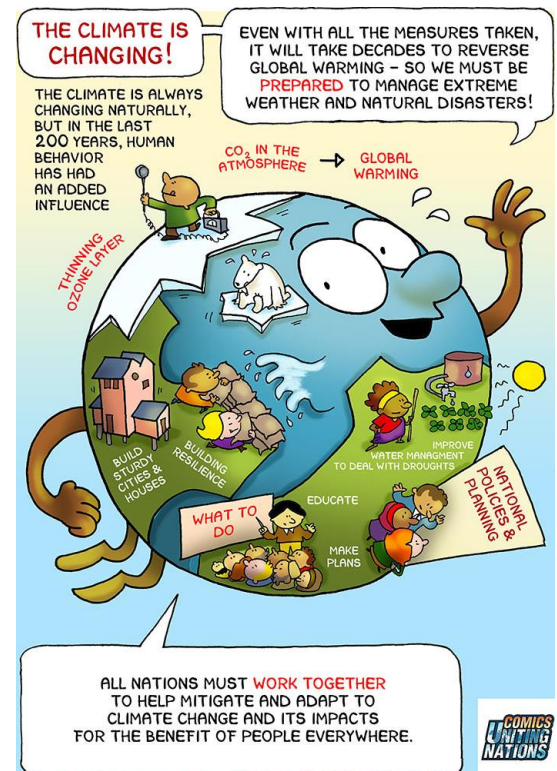
- the knowledge and understanding crucial to ensure sustainability
