CICE at Georgian

- Community Integration through Co-operative Education (CICE) is a postsecondary certificate taken over two years
- Our CICE program is offered in Barrie, Orillia and Owen Sound
- CICE is designed for individuals with diverse learning needs who require course modification and accommodation to succeed at the college level
- Modifications to course curriculum in the students' integrated classes are tailored to each student's strengths





CICE is opportunity

- The CICE program provides students with the opportunity to enhance academic and vocational skills
 - Students further their **academics** in CICE core courses and integrated courses
 - CICE students develop **vocational skills** in career-related, supervised field placement experiences







CICE field placements

- Experience three unpaid field placements
- Placements occur in semesters two, three and four
- Diverse entry-level field placement opportunities across a number of employment sectors
- Students complete a total of 336 hours of work experience







CICE admission requirements

- OSSD/Certificate or at least 19 years of age on the first day of classes
- Demonstrate academic needs that require accommodation and curriculum modification
- Sufficient level of independence
- Completion of an "Advocate Reference Form"
- Mandatory admissions interview
 - Interview about school, work, life experiences, and interests
 - Comprehension exercises
 - Reading comprehension
 - Film comprehension
