Do I have to do a Co-op Work Term as a part-time student?

Yes, Co-op Work Terms are part of the graduation requirements for all students.

If you are working full-time and are unable to complete a co-op, please connect with us to discuss your options.

Are courses delivered in the evening? Online?

Part-time students enrolled in the Civil Engineering Technician Diploma take courses along with the full-time students. There are no courses specifically scheduled in the evening. Courses are delivered on campus. The course schedules (day/time) usually becomes available 6 weeks prior to the semester start date.

There are two program courses with online equivalents and Communications and General Education courses are available online.

What is the cost of the program?

There is no program fee when studying part-time.

As a part-time student, you can take 1, 2 or 3 courses at a time in any given semester.

Payment is per course, as you register.

Program Description

Students in this program prepare to work with engineers and construction project managers as part of a team constructing roads, bridges, sewers, water mains, and other infrastructure. Students determine data for cost estimation, perform materials testing, and assist in the administration of projects in the field. Teamwork and project-based learning are emphasized. This program is common with the first four semesters of the Civil Engineering Technology program, and graduates may choose to continue into the third year of that program.
