What are the varying forms of delivery?

This program is being delivered through GC Flex. View the GC Flex ebook

What is GC Flex?

A GC Flex course means faculty deliver lectures and labs in the classroom and simultaneously online. You can choose to attend class:

- on campus, in person
- online at the same time (virtual class)
- online at your convenience you choose when you want to watch the lectures (asynchronous)

Students wanting to study online asynchronously – PLEASE NOTE – because these courses are delivered in 3 different methods, the course you register into will show a day and time – if you choose to study asynchronously, you are not required to attend live classes, either virtually or oncampus.

How do I know which courses to take?

How long will it take to complete the certificate?

This varies depending on how many courses you take each semester. Total courses: 12 plus 2 Field Placements

3 courses per semester in semester 1: finish in 6 semesters (2 years) Fall-Winter-Summer-Fall-Winter-Summer

2 courses per semester: finish in 7 semesters or under 2.5 years Fall-Winter-Summer-Fall -Winter-Summer-Fall

What is the cost of the program?

There is no program fee when studying part-time. As a part-time student, you can take 1, 2 or 3 courses at a time in any given semester. Payment is per course, as you register.

The course fees change year-to-year and course to course. The best source for accurate fees is to check the website:


