Do I have to do Co-op Work Terms as a part-time student?

Are courses delivered in the evening? Online?

Part-time students enrolled in the Honours Bachelor of Business Administration (Management and Leadership) degree take courses with the full-time students.

There are no courses specifically scheduled in the evening. Most courses in the first two years are delivered on campus. In the 3rd and 4th years of the program, many courses are delivered online. Most of the Liberal Arts courses are delivered online.

This degree CANNOT be completed fully online.

How will I know when courses are scheduled?

Schedules change semester to semester and year to year.

Courses and their sections can be viewed in Banner or on the Continuing Education website once Add/Drop opens.

If you would like to see a full listing for the semester, prior to Add/Drop, please connect with Tammy (see below). This should be available 5 weeks prior to semester start.

How do I know which courses to take?

Review the [Delivery Schedule](#) posted on the program page for information on course sequencing and availability. Students are strongly advised to follow the schedule.

Can I transfer credits/use prior learning to fast track?
